Important: a new Element 2 (Technician) question pool came into effect on July 1, 2014, effective thru June 30, 2018, new Element 3 (General) question pool became effective on July 1, 2015, effective thru June 30, 2019, and a new Element 4, and (Extra) pool became effective on July 1, 2012, effective thru June 30, 2016. Each question pool is only good for 4 years. Make sure you use the right study materials!

Ever wanted to go on a DXpedition? Ever wonder what it's like to be on the operating end of a pile-up? Well, here's your chance!


KARC has planned a "mini" dxpedition to the Janesville, Wisconsin area on Saturday, September 10.
